Description:

The University of Samarra is committed to providing a safe, accessible, and pedestrian-friendly campus environment. Pathways within the university campuses are designed with clear separation between vehicle roads and pedestrian walkways in order to improve safety and traffic organization.

Pedestrian routes are equipped with ramps and guiding blocks specially designed to support individuals with physical disabilities and facilitate safe movement across the campus. In addition, directional signs and traffic guidance boards are installed throughout pedestrian areas to help students, staff, and visitors identify locations, directions, and movement instructions easily.

To improve safety and accessibility during nighttime, pedestrian pathways are also provided with street lighting systems across the university campuses. The university continues to enhance sustainable infrastructure through energy-efficient lighting solutions, including solar-powered street lamps in several locations.



Supporting Facilities and Practices:

1. Separation barriers between vehicle roads and pedestrian pathways.
2. Ramps and guiding blocks designed for pedestrians with physical disabilities.
3. Street lighting systems for pedestrian safety during nighttime, including approximately 200 solar-powered street lamps in some campus areas with automatic light-intensity control systems.
